#### Outcome of the UN'COP21' Climate Change Meeting...

The final, legally binding agreement was signed by all 200 country delegations to great rejoicing, at the end of the UN'COP21' meeting in Paris, Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> December. Activists have responded with caution because the 'People's Test', based on climate science and needs of communities affected most by climate change worldwide, reflects a 'fail' in four key areas: (Adapted from 'New Internationalist')

### 1. Catalyze immediate, urgent and drastic emission reductions;

Outcome: Emission cuts are based on Government voluntary pledges drawn up before COP21, will take global warming to 3.7 degrees Celsius, not below 2° needed to save Earth!

## 2. Provide adequate support for transformation;

Outcome: \$100 billion was pledged, even though \$1,000 billion is required annually for the transformation to a fossil-free world by 2020. **NB** Governments spend \$5,300 billion per year on direct / indirect subsidies to fossil fuels! (\$14,000 billion was used to bail out the banks!)

## 3. Deliver justice for impacted people

Outcome: Poorer nations hit by devastating floods and droughts deserve compensation and financial support to deal with loss and damage caused by rich countries' pollution. Agreement is denying them this through the clause: 'no basis for any liability and compensation'. 'Big players' are alleged to have bribed and bullied poor nations into accepting this clause.

#### 4. Focus on genuine, effective action rather than false solutions.

Outcome: Door left open for carbon trading mechanisms, already proved totally ineffective in cutting carbon emissions! No mention of fair solutions i.e. keep 80% fossil fuels in the ground; or to respect the land rights of forest people; or to promote clean, democratic energy...
