2. **Information Sheet:** This document provides details that may be helpful to you and your students in planning for this Pilgrimage. Please forward it along with the *Participant Registration Form* to each person in your delegation.
3. **Participant Registration Form & Photograph Consent Form:** This form is to be completed by each participant—both student and staff/chaperone. The first page includes contact information, dietary or other needs and gifts to be shared with the group. On the backside/second page is a form that is to be signed by a parent/guardian of each participant who is under 18 years of age. This consent form authorizes Mercy International Association to use photos/images of students under 18 in promotional and news media.
4. **Payment Options:** This final document provides you with information on the payment options for the conference fee of €250 per person.

The Pilgrimage is limited to 150 participants, so early registration is recommended to ensure there is space for your group. Registrations must be received by Mercy International Association (either electronically or by postal mail) by ***Friday, 29th March*** (Good Friday). It would be of assistance if you gather the participant registration forms for each member of your delegation and return the completed forms together with the delegation registration form and payment.
