The GCU Online Graduate Certificate in Mercy Spirituality program combines formal academic coursework, spiritual reflection, and thoughtful dialogue with students and faculty from around the world.

- Complete and submit an application for admission with a \$40 nonrefundable admissions fee.
- Submit a statement of your interest in taking this program of graduate study.
- Submit official transcripts of all previous colleges/institutions you have attended either in sealed, signed envelopes or via electronic submission directly from the registrar's office.
- Submit two letters of recommendation.
- Applicants will be requested to participate in an interview with a program faculty member.
