2018 PROGRAMMES

Mercy Education Pilgrimage (1) 9 - 13 Jul 18

Focusing on the education tradition within Mercy, participants will have an opportunity to deepen their connection to the Mercy story. They will explore Catherine's story and her approach to leadership in the context of living Mercy today.

Cost: €620 (Residential), €410 (Non-residential)

Young Mercy Leaders Pilgrimage 31 Jul - 4 Aug 18

University students and young adults will undertake a pilgrimage in the footsteps of Catherine. Participants will emerge with a deeper appreciation of our Mercy tradition to be agents for change in a world in need of Mercy. Cost: €250 (Non-Residential only)

Mercy to Earth (1) 3 - 7 Sept 18

Participants will consider ways that we can respond to the cry of Earth and the challenge to live sustainably. This will be explored within a Mercy framework.
