# 2018 CALENDAR

## Mercy Pilgrimage 8th – 12th Jan or 9th-13th July

Focusing on the education tradition within Mercy, participants will have an opportunity to deepen their connection to the Mercy story. They will explore Catherine's story and her approach to leadership in the context of living Mercy today. Cost:  $\leq$ 620 (Residential),  $\leq$ 410 (Non-residential)

## Comfort the Sick 29th Jan – 2nd Feb

Catherine demonstrated great tenderness to those who were sick. In the context of today's ethical challenges, explore the values that motivated Catherine and the early Mercy women to provide comfort to the sick.

# Watering the Roots 20th May - 15th June

This programme is for vowed Mercy women. It offers the opportunity to discern, in an atmosphere of peace and inspiration, the invitation of the Spirit to live Mercy today. Cost: €3000 (Residential); €1900 (Non-residential)

## Young Mercy Leaders Pilgrimage 31st Jul - 4th Aug

University students and young adults will undertake a pilgrimage in the footsteps of Catherine. Participants will emerge with a deeper appreciation of our Mercy tradition to be agents for change in a world in need of Mercy. Cost: €250 (Non-Residential only)
