Thy power throughout the universe displayed.

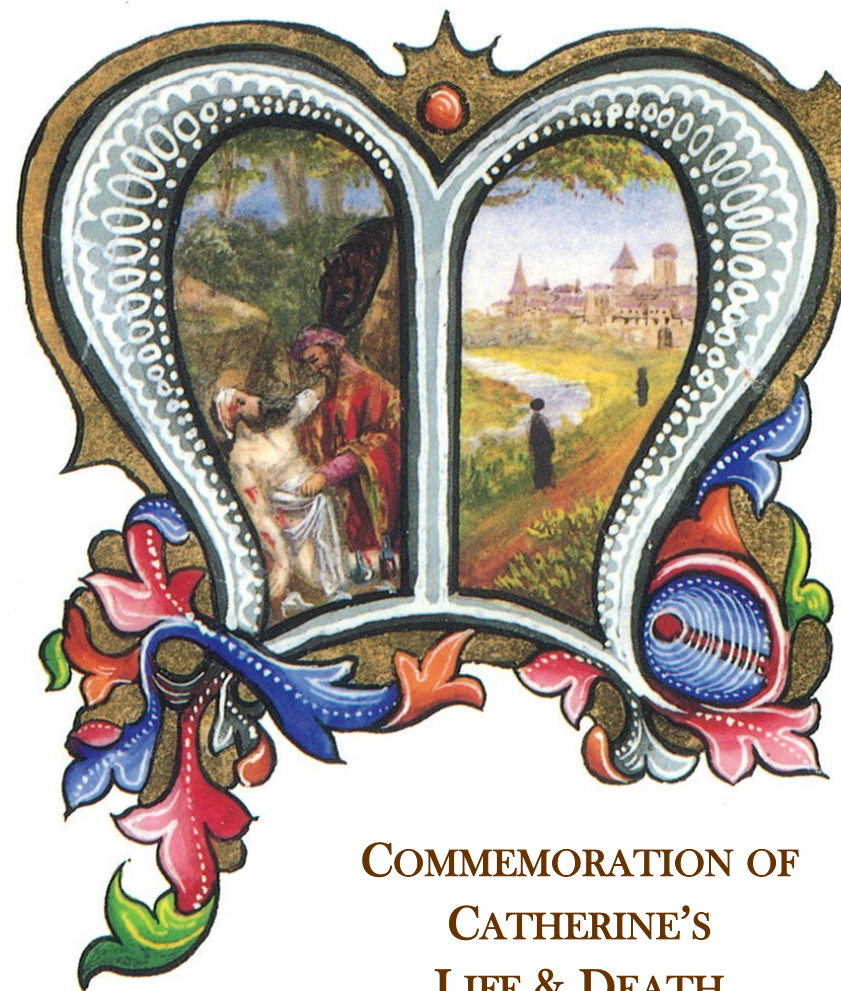
Refrain: Then sings my soul, my Saviour God to thee:
