To offer accommodation to all who participate in the renewal programmes, and others who come to visit Catherine's House.

The Team

- ❖ The Centre is staffed by a Team of eight.
- ❖ The Team lives and works at the Centre in Baggot Street in central Dublin.
- ❖ The Team is supported by live-in Sisters/Associate volunteers, Sisters of Mercy of Ireland and other volunteers.

The Position

- ❖ Team Members work in all areas of described activity.
- Other duties include participation in team meetings for the organisation and long term planning for the Centre, facilitation of renewal programmes, reception of guests, and general house responsibilities.
- Responsibilities are assigned according to the skills, experience and qualifications of each Member.

The Team Member should possess the following personal qualities and abilities:

The Terms of Appointment

- ❖ This is a two-year appointment starting in September 2003 (to be confirmed)
- ❖ An annual stipend of €13000 is paid quarterly
- Three weeks annual leave
- ❖ Additional time is granted for annual retreat
- ❖ Arrangements for the timing of retreats and holidays will be made in consultation with the Team and in consideration of the needs of the ministry.
